



OC CHARTER REVIEW COMMISSION

PINE HILLS - BARNETT PARK





Orange County voters decided to adopt the charter form of government in 1986. Every four years, a new charter review is conducted by a commission appointed by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC). The Charter Review Commission (CRC) is the reviewing group.

2024 CHARTER REVIEW COMMISSION MEETING

The CRC is not allowed to change the charter. Instead, it decides what questions, if any, to put to vote. It publishes a report at least 60 days before election-time, and then voters decide if the suggested changes will be made.

The CRC holds at least four public hearings. A variety of people make recommendations. These include elected officials, staff and the public.

Municipal Incorporation

- Criteria for Municipal Incorporation (§ 165.061, Fla. Stat.)
 - At least 2 miles from the boundaries of an existing municipality within the county
 - -Compact and contiguous and amenable to separate municipal government
 - —Population of at least 5,000 in counties with a population of more than 75,000
 - -Average population density of at least 1.5 persons per acre
 - -Have a municipal charter
 - -Honor existing solid waste contracts in area subject to incorporation

Municipal Incorporation

- Requirements for Municipal Incorporation (§ 165.041, Fla. Stat.)
 - -Charter for incorporation, adopted by special act of the Legislature
 - -Feasibility study
 - Reasons for incorporation
 - Evaluation of alternatives to address policy concerns
 - Current services and costs (water, sewer, solid waste, etc.)
 - Proposed services to be provided and costs
 - Analysis showing incorporation is necessary and financially feasible
 - Evidence of fiscal capacity and 5-year operational plan
